Primary Job Responsibilities

- 1. Creative Arts
 - Empower and cultivate artistic culture in our community, integrating appropriate expressions of arts into church's life in overall
 - b. Create and promote artistic expressions of faith, worship, and community-life in a multicultural church context
 - c. Oversee the effort to create sacred space in the relevant facilities (Sanctuary, Chapel, Lobby, Alcoves, Stage, etc.)
 - d. Manage creative team staff and volunteers (Assistant Director of Worship, Technical Artist, Worship Leaders, Vocalists, Musicians, Choral Director, Digital Ministry Assistant)
 - e. Develop and oversee 'Artist-in-Residence' program, and various artprojects, to promote and communicate Christian values in artistic ways
 - f. Develop and partner with local/national/global galleries and artists to promote and communicate Christian values in artistic ways
 - g. Manage the creative arts and worship ministry budget

2. Worship

- a. Be responsible for the programming and content of all Sunday services, series and events (including call-to-worship, prayers, song selection, video selection, video creation, scripture reading, all graphics and screen graphics, and other creative elements such as dance, theater, etc.)
- b. Lead efforts to design and craft special services, including holidays and other key events in the church calendar
- c. Oversee the resourcing of worship team (including scheduling and contacting musicians and media operators, printing and arranging music).
- d. In collaboration with the Assistant Director of Worship, recruit and develop artists and musicians both technically and spiritually
- 3. Other duties as assigned by supervisor.
 - a. Village being an integrated church oftentimes means that ministries and needs are in collaboration with other ministries. Our team's work culture highly values collaboration, support, and cooperation.

4. Shaping

- a. Supervised by and reports to Lead Pastor.
- b. Receives annual review from supervisor according to the review policy established by the Personnel Commission.
