### A Beautiful Direction

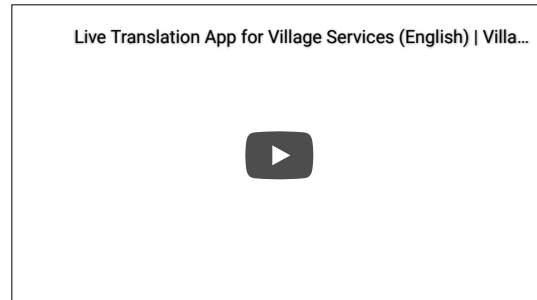
