CAMPGROUND INFORMATION & DIRECTIONS

All sites include electric/water hook-up, have a fire pit and can accommodate RVs. There is only **one vehicle allowed per site**. After that there is a \$7 per night extra vehicle fee payable to the park directly. In addition, the park only allows **8 persons per site**. If your group will have more than 8 persons, you must reserve and pay for enough sites to accommodate everyone.

Take Highway 26 west towards Cannon Beach. Go South on Highway 101 past the towns of Cannon Beach, Arch Cape and Manzanita, and follow the signs to Nehalem Bay State Park. The exit off of Highway 101 is approximately 20 miles south of Cannon Beach.

Check-in time is anytime at the registration booth after 4:00pm on the day you plan to arrive. Check-out time is 1:00pm on Sunday, August 11th (or the day you plan to leave).
