PRICING

OPTION 1

Depart US on October 19

Prior to beginning of Telos Tour, visit Stations of the Cross, Room of the Last Supper, Garden Tomb, Temple Mount, Jericho, the Dead Sea.

Depart US on October 21

FAQ

Cancellation policy

- \$200 of the deposit is non-refundable, unless there is a family emergency . We will communicate on this to see which cases can legitimately be considered as such. Full payment is non-refundable after September 10th with the same exception. This is not only to cover our work time put into planning the trip but we also incur penalties for rooms booked and cancelled. Also in case of security concerns, i.e a breakout of war that restricts travel to the region we will issue a full refund at any point before the trip. Please see below our note on security that we will also share with the group:

“Is it safe to travel to Israel/Palestine?”

- Yes. Telos has implemented over 100 delegations to the Holy Land bringing over 1500 prominent American leaders, including top CEO's, celebrities and sitting Members of Congress among hundreds of faith leaders, and thankfully have not had a security related incident. This is not to say that the region is a safe haven, because there is ongoing tension and conflict between Israelis and Palestinians, which can result in spontaneous acts of violence. However, we are constantly monitoring these events very closely and consulting daily with our local staff and friends on the ground in Israel and the Palestinian Territories.

Jordan and Ephesus

- We are happy to provide pricing and programs for a Jordan and or Ephesus (Turkey) extension, per request. We can build these as add ons and offer them on the registration link if that's of interest. Otherwise we are happy to offer suggestions of how people can do those on their own.

Transportation

- There will be a transfer arranged from the airport to the hotel and then back on the last day for the majority of those sharing a flight itinerary. This means that if for example, 11 out of 20 participants come in at or around the same time, we will arrange for the bus to pick up this main group and likewise for departure. If folks are arriving and departing hours or days before/after the main group they will be on their own in terms of getting to the hotel and starting the program with us.
- For the duration of the program, all transportation is covered. We will have a new, comfortable air conditioned bus with Wi-Fi (depending on reception), that will remain with us for the entirety of the program.
- In terms of arranging a group flight, we're happy to provide a quote for flights that get in and leave at the right time for the program and that way people can just buy the whole package and arrive and leave together.
