Beirut, Lebanon

On Tuesday, August 4, a major explosion ripped through the port of Beirut, Lebanon. As of today, over 130 people were killed with another 100 reported missing. There are reports that 5,000 people were injured and 300,000 made homeless due to destroyed buildings. In addition, grain silos that provide 85% of the country's grain were destroyed leaving the country with only a month's supply of bread. Windows were blown out of buildings miles away including Youth For Christ's Manara Center and the Carpentry Center.

All Youth for Christ staff are safe but some are staying with Scot Keranen, one of our Village workers, due to their homes being damaged. We are in contact with Scot Keranen and David & Carla Castaneda and will keep you up-to-date on their needs.
