Prayer Points

Please join us in prayer over the following items:

Discussion Questions

Take time after the service or during the week to think on these questions:

- What insight, principle, or observation from this week's message did you find to be most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? Explain.
- What are the pressures weighing on you? Consider external and internal, family and world, relationships, and work?
- Reflect on Paul's value of Christ. What things do we value more than our relationship with Christ? Why? How can we grow in our value of Christ?
- What does Paul mean by knowing Christ?
- What is the power of the resurrection? What are the ways we reduce or limit the resurrection? Why do we do this? What does the power of the resurrection call you to feel, think, and do?
- How would you define biblical joy? How are joy and the power of the resurrection related? How is joy possible in hardship?
- What do you sense God calling you to? How can our group support you this week?
