## Ministry Fund

As we enter the last quarter of the year, our greatest need is for gifts to our Ministry Fund. #### The Well

The letters of the Apostle Peter were written in the early days of the Christian church to people confronted by difficulties and troubles. Peter writes to encourage and strengthen them in the Lord Jesus. Our world too is a place of difficulty, and Peter's words also ring true for our faith. Peter exhorts believers to be absolutely certain of that which we believe, continuing to deepen our faith as we look to the Lord. Grace and peace can be ours through our hope in Christ. The Apostle himself has much to teach us. It is one of the miracles of the Gospel that the Holy Spirit empowers this impulsive headstrong man to become an eloquent defender of faith in Jesus Christ. Such change is possible for us as well!

The Well has been a wonderful place to deepen our understanding of God's Word, and to fellowship with one another. If we abide by firm COVID-19 safeguards, The Well can continue. Our interaction with one another will be in small groups, no more than 6-8 women in each group. We will watch the taped lecture together in our small groups, then discuss our lesson. We would like to meet in October/November, then break for the winter months, resuming in early spring. We will also offer a Zoom group for our high-risk health or hearing-impaired sisters. Of necessity, registration will be limited. We will meet on Tuesday mornings, from 9:00-11:00, beginning October 6th. Groups will have staggered start times for safety.

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# **Prayer Points**

- Pray for our missionaries who continue to navigate ministry during the pandemic with shutdowns, travel restrictions, and health concerns. Pray for God to bless them with creativity, increased faith, and opportunities to reach people with the gospel despite the challenges.
- · Pray for David Castaneda who is coming to Portland the first end of September and first of October. Pray for safe travel, good health and successful meetings.
- Thank God for his provision through Village and our community for all the supplies donated to help fire victims and the fire fighters this past week. Village was able to provide food and water to the front lines of fires for the fire fighters as well as provide blankets, hats, gloves, socks, and food supplies to multiple evacuation sites in Oregon.

### Sharing and Listening Guide

Take a moment to invite the Holy Spirit to minister to you through this time.

- · Ken discussed that seeing God more clearly is deeply connected to seeing ourselves more clearly. What are some spiritual disciplines you have engaged in that have brought you closer to God and where you have also seen a resulting growth in your peace, joy, and love?
- · Justification by Christ alone means that our goodness derives from God's grace in Jesus and that we approach this gospel by faith and not by the law. When have you seen grace operative in community and when have you seen legalism. From your experience, what defines the difference when we live into grace and what fruit does it bear in the community?
- · C.S. Lewis added a type of love, "Appreciation Love," to the more basic forms of gift and need love. How do you see this concept of appreciation love connecting to our understanding of grace and our worship of God?
- · What are ways that gratitude and thanksgiving could be built more deeply into your life? What are ways they could be build more deeply into the life of Village?
- Self reflective prayer: On a scale of 1-10, how worthy of love do you feel? Take some time to pray and thank God the father for his love, God the son for the grace given through his blood, and God the Spirit for animating and applying grace in your life that you may grow more fully into the image of God. Ask God to help you as you try to see yourself in the loving way he sees you.
