So many Villagers expressed their gratitude at the opportunity to learn more about each other as well as experience the caring teaching from fellow Villagers.

### Sharing and Listening Guide

In Christianity, the word "incarnation" is used to express the idea that Jesus Christ has come to earth in human form. The word is a Latin term that literally means "the act of being incarnated." This Latin term was used in John 1:14, which speaks of Jesus, who "became flesh and dwelt among us."

The Gospels of Matthew and Luke, narrate the bodily birth of our LORD JESUS CHRIST, but the Gospel of John begins by narrating His Eternity. In the book of John we see the joy of the birth of Jesus, his eternal state, we see the incarnation of Immanuel (God with us) we see God as the creator of all things and as the light of the world to all that exists

- · Jesus is the incarnation of the Father. What does the term Immanuel mean to you? Is God with us or is Today God in us.
- · Do you agree when we say that Jesus is the creator of everything that exists? See John 1: 3
- · Jesus is the light of the world John 8:12 When was the last time you shared this light with someone who walks in darkness?
