The Board of Elders and Stewardship Commission recommend a \$2.6M budget for this year which they are asking you to approve. Our Holy Father, We have endured a wave of endless change. Here flowed tears of sorrow, shouts of praise, moments of stillness, and wild rage. Here we have stood in protest. In those days, our minds were left scattered, hearts hurting, battered, our souls searching... In those days, our hands trembled in fear, strength failing to persevere, soft whispers of wonder... Lord are you near? As the months turned into a year Your people longed to feel a touch that would heal, Jesus please be revealed.
