We are honored to welcome Josh Davis and Jaewoo Kim of Proskuneo Ministries to our multigenerational service this Sunday as our final service in Missions Celebration. In 2001, Proskuneo Ministries was founded with the vision to bring nations together in worship. (Proskuneo is the Greek word for worship, meaning to bow down or kiss towards.)

Since then, Proskuneo have launched Proskuneo Worship Institute, moved to Clarkston, GA (one of the most diverse square miles in the USA), and opened the Proskuneo School of the Arts to provide free and low-cost arts training. They have produced dozens of music albums and resources, trained thousands of people in cross-cultural competencies, and led hundreds of thousands of people in multilingual worship. Our goal is to help the Body of Christ see, live, and share the vision of multicultural, Jesus-centered worshipping communities among all peoples, on earth as in heaven.
