Donate Toward Staff Love Gift

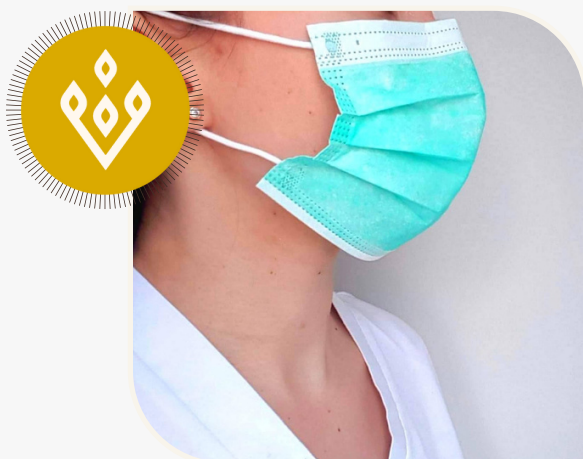
