- 5. Support a multi-staff and multi-cultural team ministry.
- 6. Be in full agreement with Village's Doctrinal Statement, Church Covenant, and Mission Statement.
- 7. Understand and be willing to submit to Village's Strategic Plan, Position Statements, and Policies.
- 8. Be a covenantal member of Village Church.

## **Primary Job Responsibilities**

Together with the leadership of the Pastor of Youth & Their Families, the Assistant Director of Worship and Youth Ministry will

- 1. Disciple Youth
  - 1. Disciple youth weekly in mentorship meetings with a particular investment in our high school girls -1-2 meetings per week
    - 1. Pray for, listen to, and care for the souls of youth, mentors, and families
    - 2. Teach and exemplify prayer & reflection on Scripture for youth
    - 3. Help youth discern the Holy Spirit's guidance, their gifting, and present them with opportunities to exercise their faith in Jesus
    - 4. Help youth connect with Village Church and Global expression of the body of Christ
    - 2. Facilitate Youth Church once a month
      - 1. Lead volunteers (youth and adults)
      - 2. Preach or leading worship with our youth
      - 3. Guide the flow of the morning
- 2. Pastor at Wednesday Night Group
  - 1. Facilitate Wednesday night middle school or high school group

- 1. Alternate facilitating Middle & High School groups with Pastor of Youth & Their Families
  - 1. co-lead the weekly Mentors Meeting
  - 2. Helping youth lead as they introduce, give announcements, run activities, lead worship, and lead groups.
- 2. Lead a small group
  - During the week: check in with your group, pray for them by name, prepare questions and ideas; occasionally meeting up with your group for discipleship & fun
  - 2. During Wednesday Night Group, lead youth in sharing life together, praying together, and mutual invitation discussion
- 3. Twice a month, preach God's Word contextualized for youth, incorporating global Christian theology, missional applications, and maturing hermeneutics.
- 3. Vision & Mission Cast
  - 1. Meet weekly with Pastor of Youth & Their Families to assess ministry strategy, pray for youth, and check-in on wellbeing as a youth pastor
  - 2. Prayerfully discern where you sense God's Spirit guiding our youth & ministry
  - 3. Choose one of the following teams to vision & mission cast with:
    - 1. Teaching, Experiences, Administration, Communication
      - 1. Together with Teaching Team & Co-Pastor, develop teaching plan -3x a year: Jan, May, September
      - 2. Together with Experiences Team & Co-Pastor, develop experiences 3x a year: February, June, October
      - 3. Together with Administration Team & Co-Pastor, update student roster & connect with families -3x a year: April, August, December
      - 2. Together with Communication Team & Co-Pastor, Communicate with Families via Weekly Email and Website Updates
- 4. Lead Teams
  - 1. Coordinate one of the following teams
    - 1. Administration, Communications, Experiences, Group Logistics, Teaching, Youth Church, Youth Council
  - 2. Organize Planning Center for Groups, including Youth Mentors, band, and Youth Council
  - 3. Participate with Youth Council meetings once a month
  - 4. Commit to ongoing reading & development as a Youth Pastor

- 6. Receives an annual review from Director of Youth Ministry (supervisor) according to the review policy established by the Personnel Commission.
